

- Admission to the college is strictly on merit basis and subject to the approval of the Admission Committee.
- There is reservation of seats for ST, SC, OBC, MOBC and physically challenged as per govt. rules. A few seats are reserved for the students having outstanding performances in co-curricular activities. These seats are allotted on merit cum proficiency in the concerned field. Candidates have to submit valid documents from the competent authority, if they apply under this category.
- Candidates are required to produce original mark sheet of last qualifying examination, admit card and original pass certificate from the Head of the institution last attended and caste certificate (if applicable) at the time of interview. Physically challenged students must produce the necessary certificate from the competent authority to that effect. Students, who passed qualifying examination earlier than the current year, must submit a gap certificate regarding their activities during this period to the satisfaction of the authority.
- Students can apply for Major course if he/she secures 50% marks in the concerned subject.
- Students who opt to Major Course have to consult with the concerned Department.
- Admission to the college takes place on the day of the interview on payment of the necessary dues.
- Regular classes will start as per notification by the principal.
- All admissions are provisional and subject to the approval of G.U.





All prospective students who wish to take admission into the GU-FYUGP, either through an affiliated college or through the FYUGP @ GU Campus, must be registered with the ABC and must obtain the 12-digit ABC ID through the Digilocker platform.

Students are encouraged to visit the ABC Website for all related information which are available along with video tutorial.

The broad admission procedure for GU-FYUGP is given in the GU-FYUGP Regulations. Some of the important points regarding admission into the GU-FYUGP through an affiliated colleges are given below.

- Admission to the GU-FYUGP should be based on desired Major of a student.
- If a student DOES NOT opt for Major, a college can devise their own rule to admit a student, based on their available infrastructure and resources.
- All syllabi including Core and Common Courses will be available by June 2023 through GU's Syllabut Portal at https://syllabus.gauhati.ac.in/fyugp.
- A college should encourage the students to obtain their respective ABC ID at the time of admission, as this will be required for Registration at GU (see below).
- All admitted students MUST register with Gauhati University (one time) immediately after the admission. The GU Registration Facility will be open immediately after the admission process is completed.
- A college can offer admission into GU-FYUGP in all subjects that are available in the Subject Page, provided they have the requisites permission from GU as well as from the Government, if any.
- Whether a college can offer Major option in a subject listed in the Subject Page is governed by existing GU rules.

Gauhati University has implemented educational programmes structured under NEP-2020 from Academic Session i.e. from 2023. It has been a quite a bit of challenge to roll out the NEP-enabled programme, especially with over more than 300 affiliated colleges ranging across the length and breadth of the State of Assam.

The undergraduate degree (UG) programme in the "Four Year Under Graduate Programme" (FYUGP) is a Choice Based Credit System under Semester Scheme. The candidate has an option to exit after TWO, FOUR and SIX semesters of the programme (at the end of each academic year) and shall be awarded Certificate, Diploma, and Undergraduate degree with Major respectively.

Two consecutive (one odd and one even) semesters will make up an academic year. An UG course shall he of eight semesters covering four Calendar Years (Academic Sessions — July to June). The duration of the Odd Semesters (First, Third, Fifth and Seventh) shall be July -December, and that of Even Semesters (Second, Fourth, Sixth and Eight) shall be January - June. Each student must take admission in four consecutive academic sessions starting with the first semester. Students who do not enrol in the second academic session will not be eligible to take admission in the third academic session and fourth academic season. Similarly, a student who do not enrol in the third academic session will not be eligible to take admission in the fourth academic session. The programme permits horizontal mobility in course selections for the students. They may pursue the three years or six semester programmes within 5 years and four years or eight semester programmes within 7 years. The programme allows the students to re-enter the course within a time of 3 years.




Fig 1: The course components of Four-Year Undergraduate Programme

# General Information



The academic session 2024-25 starts in August till December in semester system and 1st semester ends in December 2024, 2nd semester starts in January 2025 and ends in June, 2025. This is in conformity with the regulations of Gauhati University to which the college is affiliated.

# **Attendance**

It is obligatory for every student to attend the classes punctually and regularly. Attendance of a student in the Degree Course must not be less than 75% of the total lectures delivered in an academic year, as per G.U. norms. Promotion to appear in the final examination a student must qualify the minimum attendance as per norms.

# **College Hours**

The working hour of the college is from 8.30 AM to 5.30 PM. The class hour is 9.00 AM to 5.00 PM.

# **Identity Card**

An identity card is issued to every student at the time of admission. It shall contain information of the holder along with a recent passport size photograph duly attested by the Principal. The student must keep it ready to produce whenever asked for. Identity card is not transferable.

# Students' Union
